5 Project Background

The escalation of the conflict in and around Nagorno- Karabakh region that started on the 27th of September of 2020 and continued until 10 November 2020 forced large number of people to flee to Armenia and forced tens of thousands of people living near the conflict area into temporary displacement within Azerbaijan. The number of people falling under the auspices of UNHCR in Armenia has increased drastically, as a result of an increased number of persons who found themselves in a refugee-like situation in the country. According to official figures, as of 1 October 2021, 20,433 individuals from Nagorno Karabakh are currently residing in Armenia. Around 88% of these individuals were women, children and elderly. This is in addition to over 4,000 refugees and asylum-seekers who enjoy protection in Armenia. The main purpose of the project is to operate the UNHCR hotline as a complain and feedback mechanism for UNHCR activities in Armenia. The project will also help the Operation collect proxy data on protection trends and concerns in











order to inform UNHCR programming to ensure adequate response.

Expected Results

The Hotline will operate as a complaint, feedback and response mechanism for beneficiaries of previous and future UNHCR and partners projects, so that the population of concern is involved in the implementation of programmes and has opportunities to express their views, raise protection needs and concerns to have the opportunity making informed decisions and to participate meaningfully at all stages of UNHCR Operations Management Cycle. The Hotline project will allow UNHCR to keep track of all the queries, needs and complaints trying to resolve them in timely and accurate manner for the benefit of PoC. The Hotline will also allow to incorporate received feedback in further decision-making on programmes design and tailoring them to the evolving context. The Hotline will serve as a tool for collecting information regarding protection risks and concerns, needs of PoC to UNHCR and will facilitate quality referrals of them to relevant service providers.
